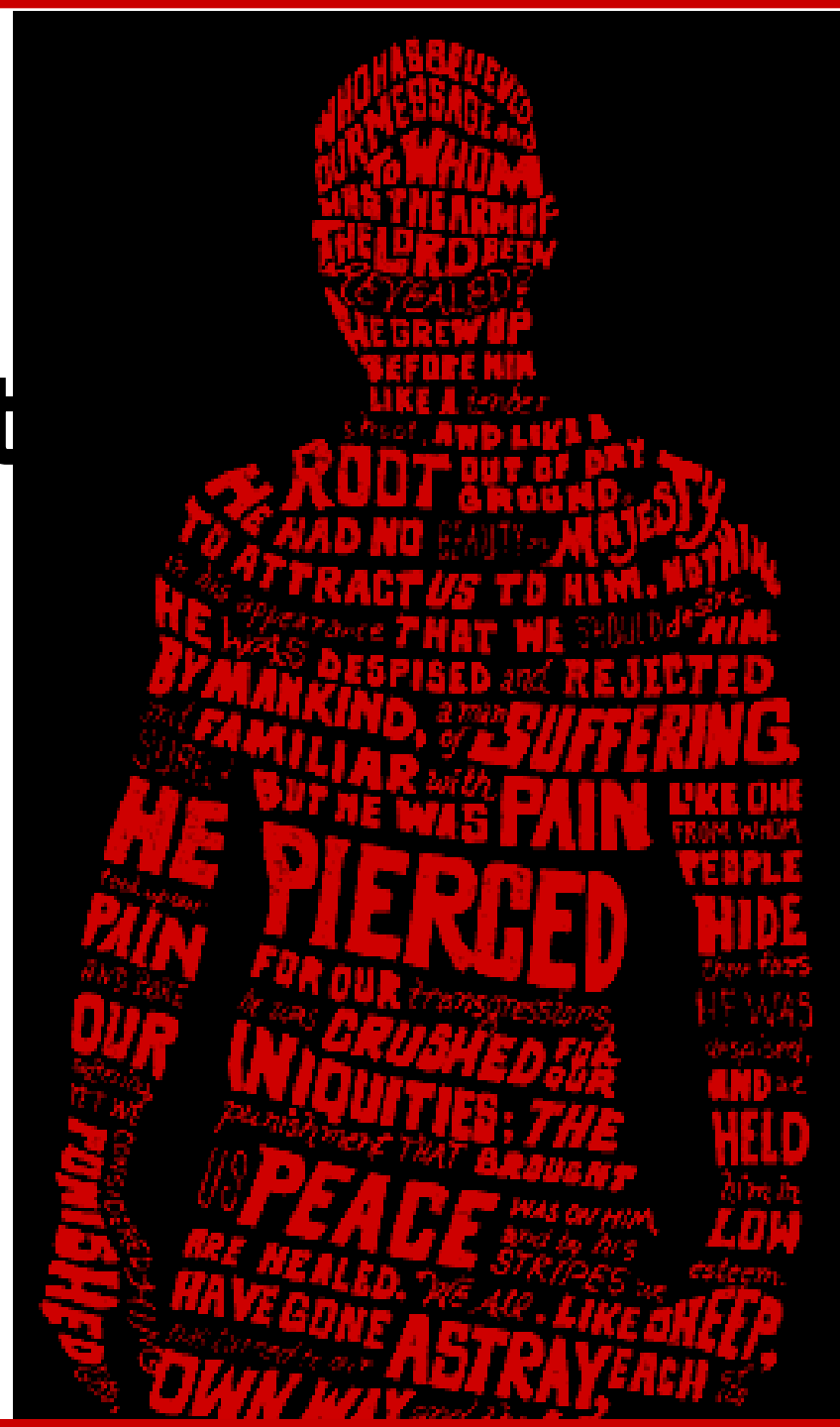


THE SUFFERING SERVANT – Part

ISAIAH 5

3



"How foolish you are, and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Did not the Messiah have to suffer ...?" (Luke 24: 25,26)

*Jesus explained to his disciples that **he must go to Jerusalem and suffer ... and ... be killed** and on the third day be raised to life. Peter ... began to rebuke him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to you!" Jesus said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."*

(Matt 16. 21-23)

been revealed? (Isaiah 53:1)*

The Person and Work of the Servant Does Not Appear Attractive

- Isaiah 53:2

For He grew up before Him like a tender shoot, And like a root out of parched ground; He has **no stately form or majesty** That we should look upon Him, **Nor appearance that we should be attracted to Him.**

The Suffering Servant is Rejected

- **Isaiah 53:3**

He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; And like one from whom men hide their face, He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

... *"Give us a king to lead us," this displeased Samuel ... And the Lord told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying; it is not you they have rejected, but **they have rejected me** as their king. As they have done from the day I brought them up out of Egypt until this day, forsaking me and serving other gods*
(1 Samuel 8:6-8)

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Philippians 2:6-8

who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross.

“And we esteemed Him not” (53:3d).

The world was made through Him, and the world knew Him not He came unto His own, and His own received Him not (John 1:10,11).

The World (Jews and Gentiles) Thinks God Punished The Servant

- **Isaiah 53:4**

Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted.

The Covenant of Redemption

구속언약

- the covenant between the father and the son made before the foundations of the world.
- all according to God's Redemptive plan to redeem those whom the Father had given His Son.

No one takes it from me, but I lay it down
of my own accord. I have authority to lay
it down and authority to take it up
again. (John 10:18)

A suffering servant **acquainted** with our sorrows and our grief

Since the children have flesh and blood, he too **shared** in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil ... For this reason he had to be made like them—fully human in every way, ... that he might make atonement for the sins of the people. Because **he himself suffered** when he was **tempted**, **he is able to help those who are being tempted.**

(Hebrews 2:14-18)

A suffering servant **acquainted** with our sorrows and our grief

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to **empathize with our weaknesses**, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

(Heb. 4:15,16)
