Matthew 7:1-8

- ¹“Do not judge, or you too will be judged.
- ²For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.
- ³“Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother’s eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?
